### INSTALLATION AND SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

F-Secure Mobile Security™ 6 for S60 3<sup>rd</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> edition client application supports devices running on top of Symbian 9.1, 9.2, 9.3, and 9.4 versions. The installation of the client application requires about 1.5 Mb of free disc space. The activation and updates require a working internet connection. Note! MMS access point does not work for updates, and there are also limitations with the use of WAP access point(s).

### SUPPORTED DEVICES

F-Secure Mobile Security™ 5.1 for S60 3<sup>rd</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> edition client application supports devices running on top of Symbian 9.1, 9.2, 9.3, and 9.4 versions. The list of supported devices is maintained at <http://mobile.f-secure.com/devices/index.html>.

Note! Browsing protection functionality is not available for Symbian 9.1 devices.

## LANGUAGE SUPPORT

F-Secure Mobile Security™ supports 24 languages. The language is selected based on the device language. In case the device language is not supported, user is shown the list of supported languages. Full list of supported languages is at <http://mobile.f-secure.com/devices/index.html> .

## KNOWN ISSUES

- FSMS software binary update (OTA) can block Push email synchronization. Push email recovers after the client is restarted.
- Browsing protection doesn't work through WAP access point in certain devices.
- E90 when FSMS detects and quarantines "curse of silence" SMS message the SMSs are not working until the SMS is deleted.
- Browsing protection doesn't work in Initial Release devices (Symbian 9.1).
- N76 cleaning from "curse of silence" SMS needs booting of the device
- N73 "curse of silence" SMS cannot be deleted by FSMS, however this device is not affected by that SMS
- Blocked total and Blocked today counts in Firewall status may show briefly different counts even though all blocked connections would have occurred "today". This happens because the blocked total count is kept in settings and the blocked today count is kept only while FSMS is running.
- Scanned today count will show that some files has been scanned after the restart of FSMS even if the scanning mode was manual. This is because the client application scans it's own files at start-up.
- Anti-theft lock in not turned ON if lock SMS comes during the call. The locking is done after the call.
- Scan statistic are not updated in real-time. The statistics are updated to the final result after the scan has completed.
- Browser's WLAN search doesn't always work with FSMS.
- FSMS uninstallation fails if help is opened into background.
